Marketing

At various places on our web site, we provide opportunities for you to send us your name, address, and other personal information about yourself. If you choose to send us this type of information, we may store it and we may use it for market research and marketing purposes, which may include sharing it with other companies in the 'Advent' Group of Companies and with our business partners, affiliates or third parties who may use it to inform you by letter, telephone or email about their products or services (which may not be financially related).

Other information collected by 'Advent's' website

'Advent' may gather a certain amount of anonymous information about users which does not personally identify you, but which may be helpful for marketing purposes or for improving the services we offer. For example we may track how many users visit a certain page, and for how long, so we can measure whether the site is effective.

Generally this information is collected through "traffic data" and may entail the use of "Cookies" and "IP addresses".

Definition of "Cookie"

A "Cookie" is a message given to a web browser by a web server. Your web browser then stores the message in a text file on your computer. Each time the browser requests a page from the server, this message is sent back. A cookie's main objective is to identify users and personalise their visit by customising web pages for them for example by welcoming them by name next time they visit the same site. A site using cookies will usually invite you to provide personal information such as your name, e-mail address and interests.

Transfer of Information Abroad
